



COVID-19 ATTENDANCE POLICY

Patients who are experiencing any symptoms of CORONAVIRUS or are currently self-isolating are NOT TO ENTER THE PRACTICE and will need to re-arrange their appointments by telephone or email.

Our aim is to keep our patients, visitors and staff safe. We set a high standard of cross infection control and require all visitors to the practice to comply with our safety requirements.

We require all visitors to the practice to:

Come to your appointment alone unless attending with a parent/carer

Wear a face mask/covering while in the building (you will be asked to remove it while in surgery) – **If you are medically exempt please alert us before your appointment**

We require that you use the hand sanitiser provided before entering

Arrive 5 minutes early for your appointment. Unfortunately, due to the way we have to run our clinics and disinfection times, late arrivals will not be able to be seen

Please wait in your car & **text 07928435138** to announce your arrival. We will call to invite you in

If you need to use the bathroom facilities, please notify a staff member so that we can undertake a thorough cleaning protocol – Please note, toothbrushing is prohibited

Any payments may be made at reception, by card only please

We reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone failing to comply to these regulations.
